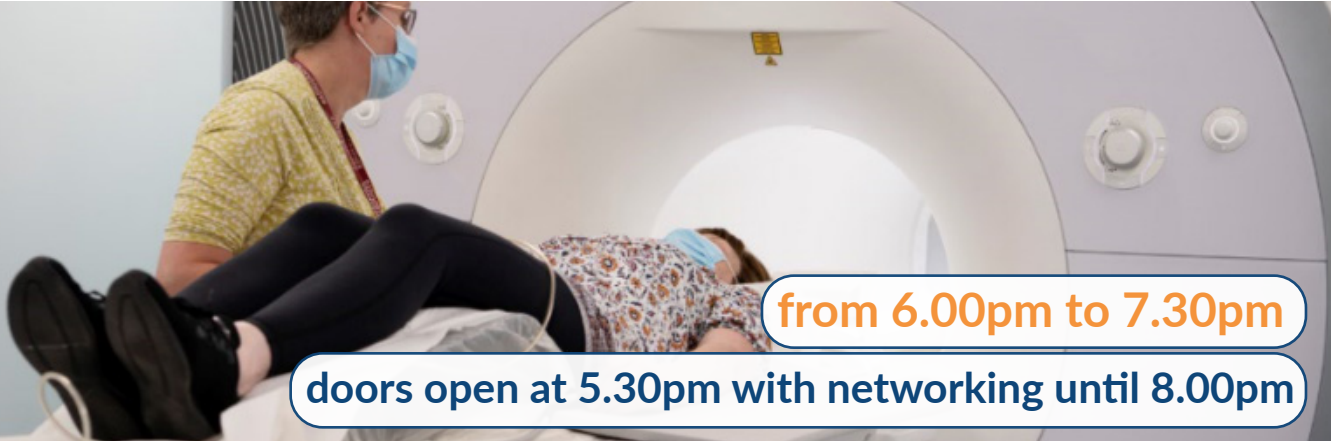




What difference does research make in improving hospital care?
