Health and Care Research Explained: A Training Environment (CREATE)

This online and live interactive learning package is primarily for those who have worked in research delivery for less than 12 months and could also be beneficial for those with more experience as a refresher.

An Introduction to Research in the NHS

Introduction To Good Clinical Practice Consolidation Workshops

PRES is used to measure the experience of a participant who takes part in health and social care research. This training package is designed to help you understand how you can use the PRES in your studies and why it is important.

Participant in Research Experience Survey (PRES): Responding to the Survey

This training will demonstrate the importance of looking at and responding to the results of the Participant in Research Experience Survey, also known as the PRES.

Fundamentals of Clinical Research Delivery in the Ambulance Setting

This course has been developed for all ambulance staff who will be taking an active role in the clinical research delivery. This session does NOT provide full Good Clinical Practice (GCP) training. You may be asked to take part in a full GCP training course if your role requires it.
